As a Skate Rental & Ice Bumper Car Attendant, you'll play a key role in bringing energy, connection, and joy to downtown Minot during the winter months. This position primarily supports ice bumper cars and ice skate rentals, while helping create a fun, safe, and welcoming experience for guests of all ages.

You'll be hands-on with daily rink operations and winter activities from assisting families onto the ice to supporting seasonal events. Along the way, you'll gain experience in recreation operations, event support, and community engagement in one of Minot's newest public spaces.

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Assist guests with ice bumper cars, including buckling riders, clearly explaining safety rules, and moving cars on and off the ice
- Support ice skate rentals, including sizing assistance, skate preparation, and intake/returns
- Use iPad-based technology to manage bumper car and skating sessions
- Help set up, operate, and take down daily winter recreation elements, including rink amenities, warming areas, and seating
- Support guest hospitality by tending the firepit, tidying the space, taking out trash, and completing light shoveling as needed
- Perform basic bumper car care, including charging, inflating, and securing equipment
- Assist with additional winter events, themed skate nights, and community gatherings as needed
- Welcome visitors, answer questions, and serve as an on-site resource for guests, partners, and vendors
- Work collaboratively with team members, volunteers, and community partners to support smooth operations

- Upbeat, reliable, and comfortable engaging with the public
- Enjoys being active and working outdoors in winter conditions
- Organized, adaptable, and able to problem-solve on the fly
- Interested in recreation, events, hospitality, or community-focused work
